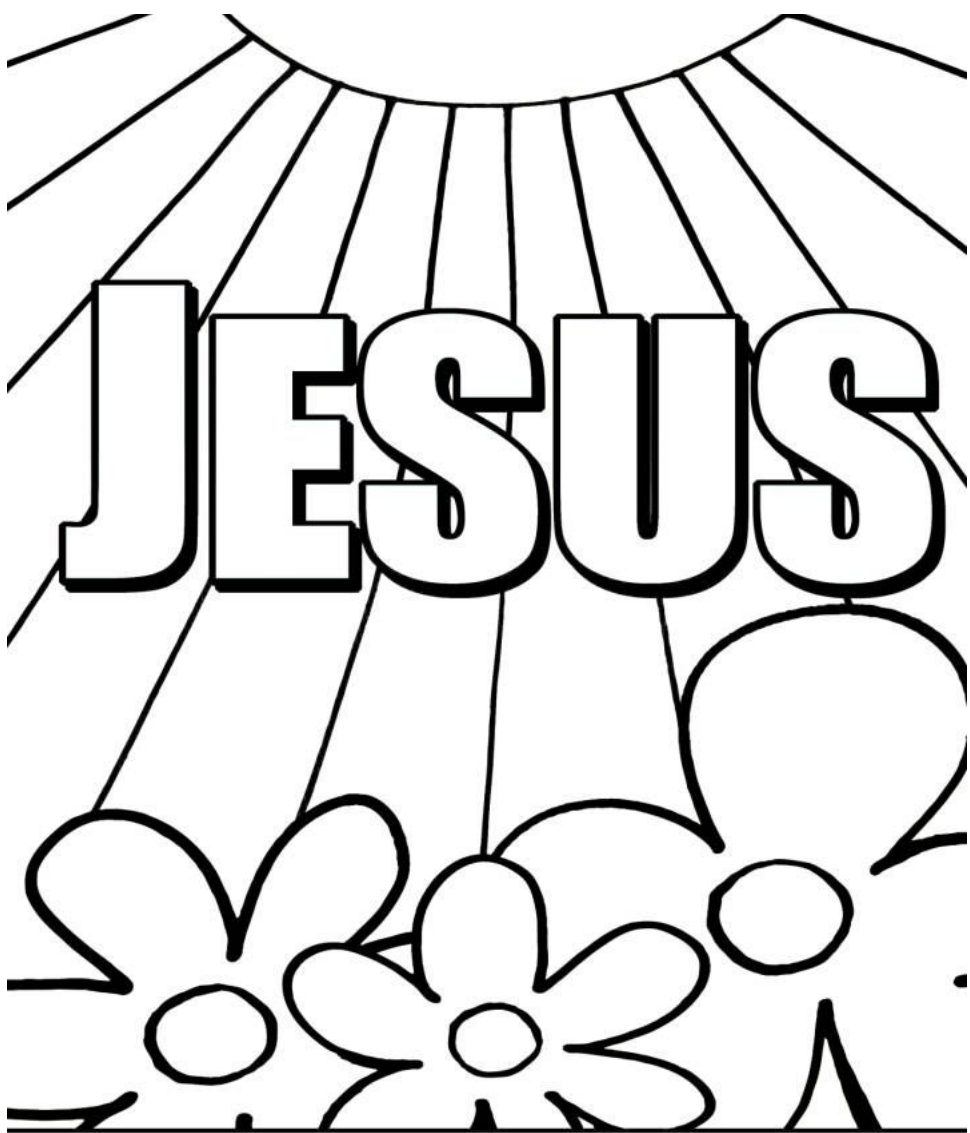
GOSPEL READING • John 8:12-20

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the light of the world.
