CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN • Isaiah 44:21-22

Remember these things, O Jacob, and Israel, for you are my servant;
I formed you; you are my servant; O Israel, you will not be forgotten by me.
I have blotted out your transgressions like a cloud and your sins like a mist;
return to me, for I have redeemed you.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Holy Trinity, God of love, our Creator and Redeemer; we are living paradoxes. Even though you made us in your image, we distort the reflection of your glory in our self-love. Hear us as we pray in the words of the Lord himself, saying



"Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you.'" (John 20:21)


"Christian baptism is a naming ceremony. The baptized is given a name: the name of the Triune God. Baptism gives Christians their family name, the name they bear as those called the children of God." (Ed Clowney)

"Baptism is a part of the mission to the nations." (Dan Doriani)

"To disciple a person to Christ is to bring him into the relation of a pupil to teacher, 'taking his yoke' of authoritative instruction (Matt. 11:29), accepting what he says as true because he says it, and submitting to his requirements as right because he makes them." (John Broadus)

"Disciples are those who hear, understand, and obey Jesus' teaching... It is binding on *all* Jesus' disciples to make others what they themselves are—disciples of Jesus Christ... Christianity must spread by an internal necessity or it is already decayed; for one of Jesus' commands is to teach all he commands. Failure to disciple, baptize, and teach the peoples of the world is already itself one of the failures of our own discipleship." (D. A. Carson)

CONFESSION OF FAITH • The Nicene Creed

What do you believe?

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible.

And we believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of the Father before all worlds; God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God; begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who, for us and for our salvation, came down from heaven, and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; he suffered and was buried; and the third day He rose again, according to the Scriptures; and ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of the Father; and He shall come again, with glory, to judge the living and the dead; whose kingdom shall have no end.

And we believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of Life; who proceeds from the Father and the Son; who with the Father and the Son together is worshiped and glorified; who spoke by the prophets. And we believe in one holy catholic^{*} and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins; and we look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.
