


CALL TO WORSHIP • Psalm 33:8

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN • Colossians 2:6-7

CONFESSION OF SIN

Give us this day our daily bread.


And forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors.

For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.


Away In A Manger

GOSPEL READING • Matthew 5:1-12

SERMON • "Blessed Are Those Who Mourn" (Rev. Eric Costa)

"The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; ² to proclaim the year of the LORD's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn; ³ to grant to those who mourn in Zion—to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning..." (Isaiah 61:1-3a)

"To love at all is to be vulnerable. Love anything, and your heart will certainly be wrung and possibly be broken. If you want to make sure of keeping it intact, you must give your heart to no one, not even to an animal. Wrap it carefully round with hobbies and little luxuries; avoid all entanglements; lock it up safe in the casket or coffin of your selfishness. But in that casket – safe, dark, motionless, airless – it will change. It will not be broken; it will become unbreakable, impenetrable, irredeemable. The alternative to tragedy, or at least to the risk of tragedy, is damnation." (C. S. Lewis)
